Tennis Court & Pickleball Guidelines - 2023

The Court Committee's goal to the insure all court players have an opportunity to enjoy the Shorewood Hills tennis court amenity in a fair and orderly manner.

To accommodate both the Tennis and Pickleball enthusiasts, during the 2023 court season, it is proposed that we continue our playing process in the manner of the 2022 season with dedicated court reservations in the following form:

Weekends:

We are to alternate Saturday and Sunday 8:00 am to 11:00 pm playing times.

Example: Saturday Pickleball players play 8 - 11 am; Sunday, Tennis players get the 8 - 11 am slot.

Following week: Saturday Tennis players play 8 - 11 am; and Sunday, Picklebal players get the 8 - 11 am slot.

The dedicated weekend schedule begins the first week of May, with Pickleball beginning on Saturday the 6th and Tennis follows on Sunday the 7th and continuing the alternate schedule.

Weekdays:

Dedicated time for Pickleball beginner's and intermediate groups: Mondays; 8 - 11am.

We will be offering a "Introduction to pickleball class" introducing the game to all comers, reviewing Pickleball rules and performing skills exercises June 12, June 19 and June 26th.

Dedicated court times for Tennis players are Thursdays; 8 - 11 am Dedicated court times for Pickleball players are Wednesdays; 8 - 11 am

Reserving courts:

- 1. Shorewood members can reserve a court for the following day any time after 5:00 pm. Your card reserves a court for one hour. No individual player can book a consecutive hour; although any player can play continuously if someone in the group booked additional hours. No card left on the board for two days will be honored as legitimate reservation.
- Courts are booked for one hour intervals and players are expected to vacate the court on the hour. For example, players that start at 1:30 are to vacate the court at 2:00. If no one is waiting, players can continue playing.
- 3. A second nail will be added to court reservation board to reserve one or two courts for pickleball. Two separate cards are required to reserve both pickleball courts.
- 4. At all times, when only one tennis court is being used, others can play on the other court their preferred game.
- 5. Peak playing times are 8:00 am 11:00 pm seven days a week. During these times, there are not to be more than two non-resident players per court.

- 6. Tennis and Pickleball each have two (2) dates per year for tournaments requiring all day special schedules.
 - -Pickleball Tournament: Saturday, July 15, 2023. All courts will be used for the SaturdayTournament.
 - -Picklepalooza: Saturday, September 17? All courts will be used for Saturday Tournament.
 - -Tennis Tournaments to be announced.
